Aaron Konopasky is a Senior Attorney Advisor in the ADA/GINA Policy Division at the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) headquarters in Washington, D.C., where he assists the Commission in interpreting and applying Title VII of the Civil Right Act of 1964, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and other federal employment discrimination statutes. Dr. Konopasky has participated in the development of regulations under the ADA, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967 (ADEA), and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as well as numerous policy documents and other Commission publications. Dr. Konopasky joined EEOC after receiving his J.D. from Stanford Law School.
