



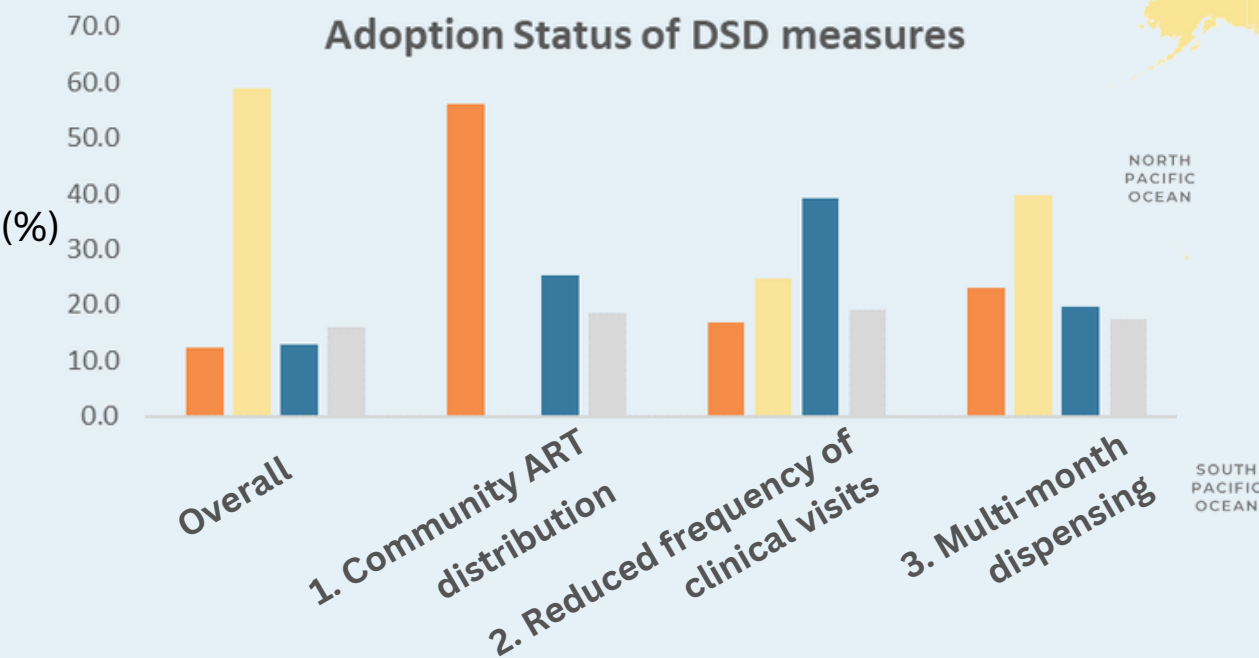
What is the HIV Policy Lab?

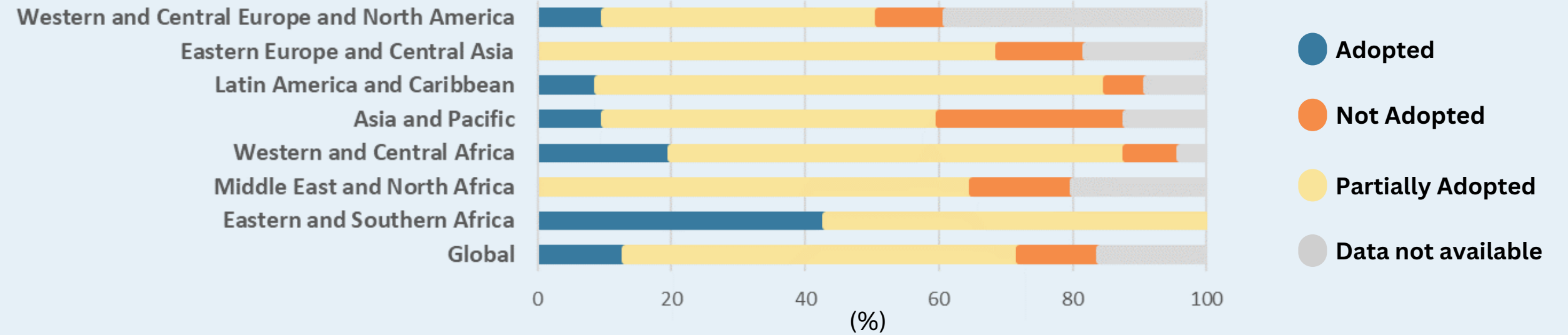
Why Differentiated Service Delivery (DSD)?

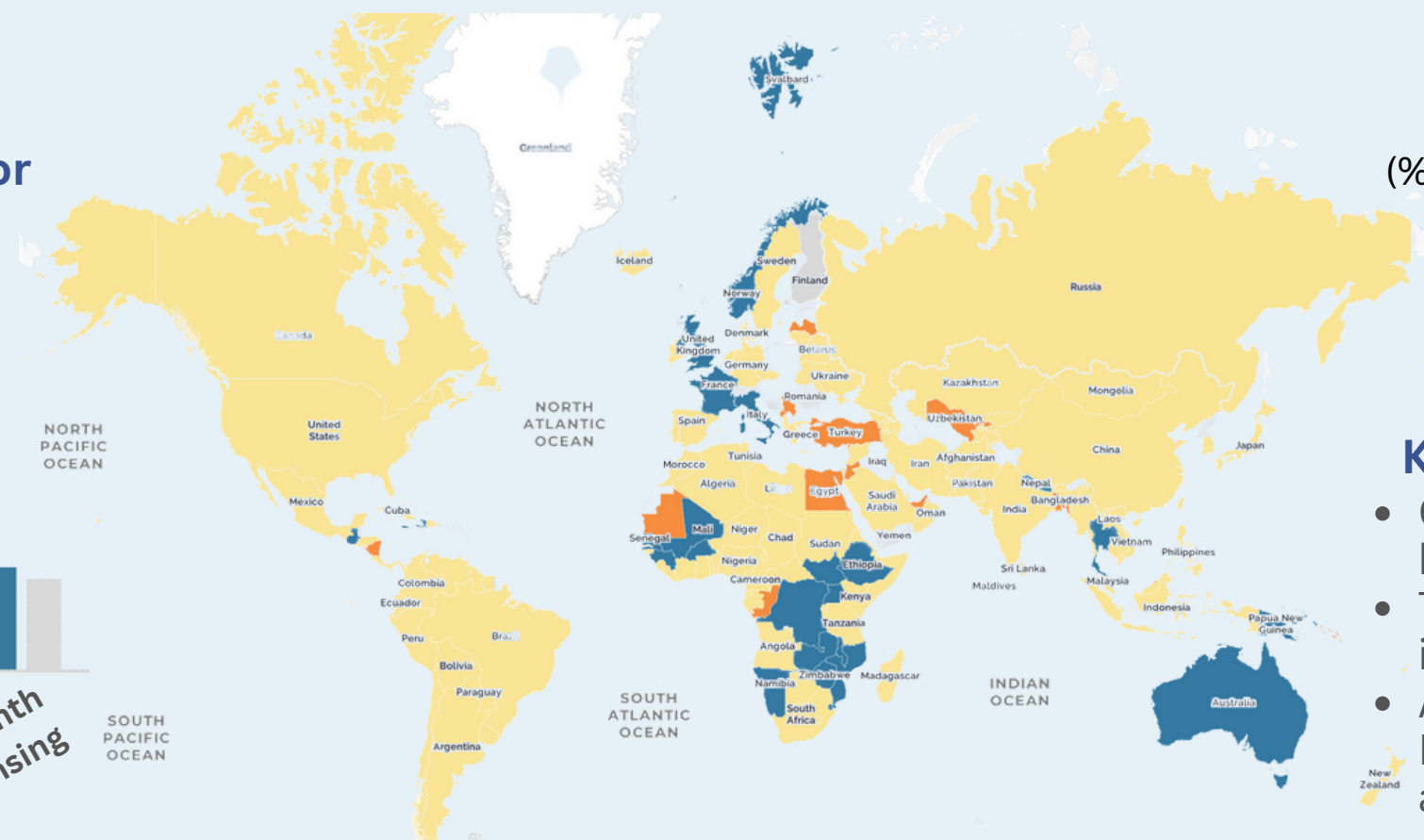
HIV Policy Lab measures if a nation allows for the below DSD policies



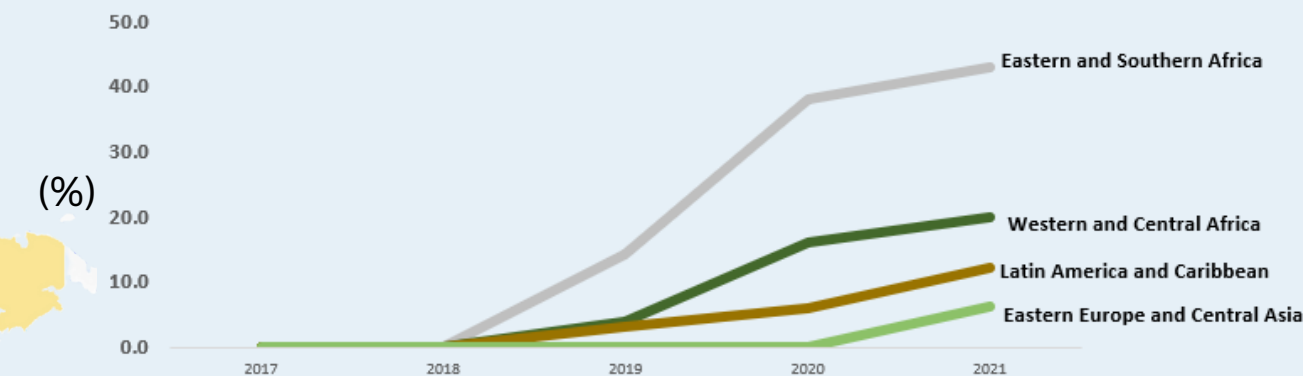
Do national HIV treatment policies include multiple options for differentiated HIV treatment services?
