Dr. Jean-Claude Mulunda

Dr. Jean-Claude Mulunda is Country Director of Ipas in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and also leads the organization's work in Burundi. Ipas is a global reproductive justice organization focused on access to abortion and contraception around the world. Dr. Mulunda is a medical doctor and public health professional and an outspoken advocate for sexual and reproductive justice. His expertise covers strategic thinking, organizational capacity building, strategic partnerships, health system strengthening, humanitarian response, donor cultivation, and fundraising. For more than 12 years, Dr. Mulunda has advocated for universal access to high-quality, comprehensive sexual and reproductive health services, including safe abortion care, leading initiatives aimed at reducing gaps and inequality in access to sexual and reproductive health services and maternal mortality, strengthening women's bodily autonomy, and empowering women and girls. He played an instrumental role in the Maputo Protocol domestication and Comprehensive Abortion Care Standards and Guidelines development processes in the DRC and, over the last six years, has worked in close collaboration with in-country partners, government officials, parliamentarians, and donors. Previously, he managed sexual and reproductive health projects for the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees and International Planned Parenthood's DRC affiliate. Dr. Mulunda received medical training from the University of Kinshasa and a Master's in Global Sexual and Reproductive Health from Dalarna University in Sweden and a program Management Certification in Israel.
